### Picture Composition

In this chapter, we are going to learn how to write a picture composition. We will learn to describe a picture with the help of various examples. One of the crucial concepts covered in first-year classes is picture composition. Students can compose a query or a response using the hints in the picture in this situation. Picture composition is just as crucial as composition. You are also provided with practice questions to assess yourself.

#### Picture composition:

Picture compositions help in understanding how to construct sentences, stories, paragraphs, essays, etc. This helps to increase creativity and verbal prowess. A student who regularly practises composition can produce any paragraph or essay. In picture composition students are required to produce a composition using the supplied picture. Students will receive hints to aid in composition writing.

#### What components make up a picture's composition?

Patterns, textures, asymmetry, symmetry, the field of view, lines, arcs, screens, contrast, colour, viewpoint, depth, space, protagonist, background, visual tension, and shapes are all compositional elements. Build a composition that fits your picture by incorporating a few of these components.
