#### Chapter 10 – Hu Tu Tu, Hu Tu Tu

**1. When you play Kabaddi, how many players are there in a team?**

**Ans:** In kabaddi, each team consists of seven players. In the game of kabaddi, each team has 12 players, but only 7 of them play at a time, with the remaining 5 players serving as reserves.

**2. How many players got out when Shyamala touched the line?**

**Ans:** When shyamala crossed the line, the other team's whole lineup was ejected.

**3. Do you have ways to resolve disputes in games?**

**Ans:** Yes, we have methods for resolving disagreements in games.

**4. a. Try to hold your breath and keep saying Kabaddi- Kabaddi. How many times could you say it?**

**6. What does it mean to be out in games? When does one get 'out' in Kabaddi?**

**Ans:** In games, being "out" means that the player who is "out" can't participate for a period of time in the same game. In kabaddi, one is ejected if he loses his breath while playing for the opposing team.

**Ans:** Games in which we have to touch things or colours include the lemon race, altering the colour box according to music, choosing a colour, and so more.

**10. Do girls in your area play Kabaddi or any other outdoor game? If there are girls who do not play, then what are the reasons for them not playing? Discuss.**

**Ans:** Yes, girls in my neighbourhood play kabaddi and other outdoor sports like kho-kho, cricket, and so forth. Yes, there is one girl in my neighbourhood who does not play these games due to an accident in which she hurt her left leg.
