Chapter 10 – The Beggar

1. Has Lushkoff become a beggar by circumstance or by choice?

Ans: Circumstances force Lushkoff to become a beggar. He used to sing in the choir and was a talented singer. In the church, the choir sings. Because of his alcoholism, he lost his work. He was unable to get work after leaving the recovery center due to the societal stigma of being an alcoholic. He had to resort to begging to make ends meet.

2. What reasons does he give Sergei for his telling lies?

Ans: He claims that if he told the truth, no one would donate alms. It's similar to how beggars dress and whine about being hungry for days.
